COMMENTS ON Q3 PERFORMANCE



- The performance of Q3 FY 2011 is not representative of the full year performance.
- As against production of 4024 MVA in Q3 FY 2011 the sales are of 2711 MVA and dispatches of around 1300 MVA would be billed in Q4 FY 2011.
- There is an increase in the employees cost in Q3 by way of a "one off" expenditure relating to payment of arrears and incentives in Q3.
- There is also an increase in the incidence of employees cost and other expenditure owing to the developmental expenses relating to the 1150 KVA transformer debited under the respective heads as revenue expenses.
- The company maintains the revenue guidance of around 14000 MVA for FY 2011; and also the EBIDTA guidance for FY 2011 in line with the 9 months YTD EBIDTA.

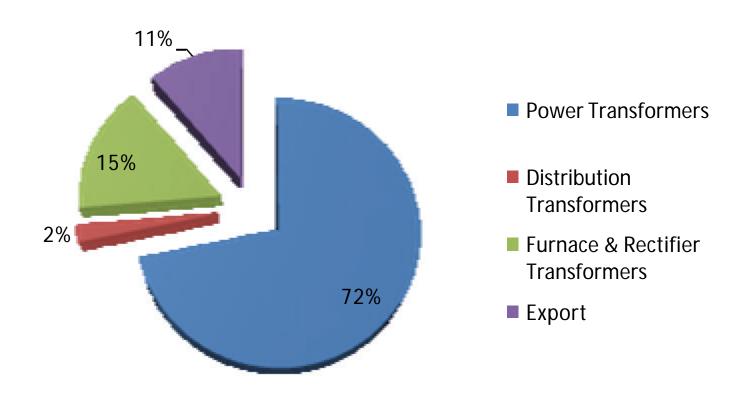
